DeKalb Fire Station No. 26 Opens

Atlanta, Georgia, January 19, 2007 – DeKalb County’s new two-story Fire Station No. 26, a Prime Engineering design and construction administration project, has officially opened for service. The one-acre site, featuring a firehouse with patio, living quarters, kitchen, parking lot, and adjacent water tower, will serve the residents of Decatur.
